



Team Leader for a women's economic empowerment programme

Successful candidates will have excellent networks with businesses, significant experience in gender-related programming, working in partnership with corporates for supply chain initiatives and in managing teams in complex projects across multiple countries. They will combine prior experience in managing large-scale, complex programmes in a range of African and Asian countries with direct experience of working for, or advising, businesses on women's economic empowerment.

Scope of the programme

The programme will aim to catalyse a market-based approach for private sector delivery of improved access for women to economic opportunities through business interventions in supply chains and economic development programmes. It will focus specifically on higher return and higher productivity jobs and roles in supply chains as well as acting as a global voice for transparency on women's roles in supply chains. The programme will provide technical and financial assistance to global and British businesses with supply chains in countries such as Nigeria, Ghana, Kenya, Ethiopia, Bangladesh, Pakistan, India and Myanmar to help them design and implement interventions to improve outcomes for women in their supply chains. The programme will also have a focus on improving data and transparency on women's work in supply chains, supporting and advising on DFID and HMG programming on economic development to improve outcomes for women and girls and supporting partnerships and initiatives that respond to the recommendations of the UN HLP report.

Scope of the Team Leader role

The Team Leader's responsibilities will include:

- Providing overall strategic and technical direction for the programme with responsibility for delivering development impact at scale and a high-quality service
- Leading, managing and supervising delivery teams comprising long- and short-term team members and consortium partners
- Building relationships with high-level stakeholders across several different countries, in particular with the business community and at senior levels of government
- Acting as the 'public face' of the programme and ensuring it has a strong voice among development practitioners, country governments and other stakeholders

The Team Leader will work closely with a Programme Manager, who will have responsibility for day-to-day operational issues (programme plans, resourcing, forecasting, reporting, risk management etc.).

Desirable qualities:

- Experience in high-level stakeholder engagement and previous experience working with donors such as DFID, USAID, etc.



- Experience leading large-scale donor programmes in developing countries, preferably in the eight countries outlined above;
- Technical understanding or background in women's economic development, private sector engagement and substantial existing networks with business, economic development programming, supply chain transparency and advocacy of women's role in economic activity;
- Able to commit to the programme for the long-term, on a substantial basis (part-time / full-time arrangements can be discussed, although the role would require a substantial commitment);
- Willing to undertake overseas travel to multiple African and Asian countries.

Location:

The role is expected to be based in London.
