THE POSITION

We are looking for an experienced professional in the field of impact investing and/or strategic giving with a large and relevant network in the UK and Ireland. An inspirational person to build and grow the community, bring relevant knowledge and support to our members and support knowledge sharing between the UK and EVPA member outside the UK. For this role we are looking for a senior talent who is able to naturally connect to executive leaders from foundations and social impact investment funds, philanthropists and Angel Investors. The role is currently assessed at approximately 90 - 100 days per year (average 2 days a week) with the possibility to be flexible around main events.

MAIN TASKS & RESPONSIBILITIES
